

# Information – School visit

We look forward to welcoming your school group to Fabrique des Lumières soon! This information will help you prepare for your school visit, to make your experience as pleasant as possible.

## ✨ Before the visit

Inform the students about their visit to Fabrique des Lumières: what they will experience, what they can expect and what our house rules are.

## Exhibitions

During their visit to Fabrique des Lumières, students will see art come to life. What will they experience?

- Moving projections on the floor and walls, accompanied by music.
- 3 exhibitions: In The Hall: Dalí, *The Endless Enigma* and Gaudí, *Architect of the Imaginary*.  
In the studio: *Recoding Entropia*.
- It is a self-guided visit (not a guided tour).
- A visit takes one hour in total.

## House rules

We like to ensure that all visitors have a pleasant experience. Therefore, the following house rules apply:

- You are invited to touch the walls in the exhibition space. The walls react to your touch.
- Taking pictures is allowed, but without a flash.
- Running and shouting is not permitted.
- Eating and drinking in the exhibition space is not permitted.
- In the event that our house rules aren't being followed, a security officer will address the relevant teacher.
- The teacher is responsible for the group at all times and must remain with the students throughout the visit.

## How to get to Fabrique des Lumières

Make sure to plan your route before your visit to Fabrique des Lumières. Our address is: Pazzanistraat 37 in Westerpark, Amsterdam.

Cars and buses are not permitted on the Westerpark terrain.

### **The Visit**

- Upon arrival, one teacher should present themselves to the ticket booth with the group ticket (printed or on a smartphone). One of our hosts will guide the group to the gates and let everyone in.
- A limited number of lockers may be found at the entrance, for jackets and bags. We kindly request you bring as little with you as possible. Students may also bring their bags into the exhibition spaces, but must wear their bag at all times.

### **Accessibility**

Fabrique des Lumières is accessible for wheelchair users. The exhibitions and disabled toilet are located on the ground floor.

### **After the visit**

You will receive an invoice within 1 month after the school visit. Schools located in the Netherlands can also opt to pay via the Cultuurkaart.
